Philippians Series Part 4
Text: Phil. 1:19-26
Title: "To Live is Christ!"

Philippians 1:19–26 (ESV) ¹⁹for I know that through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus Christ this will turn out for my deliverance, ²⁰as it is my eager expectation and hope that I will not be at all ashamed, but that with full courage now as always Christ will be honored in my body, whether by life or by death. ²¹For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. ²²If I am to live in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me. Yet which I shall choose I cannot tell. ²³I am hard pressed between the two. My desire is to depart and be with Christ, for that is far

better.

²⁴But to remain in the flesh is more necessary on your account.
 ²⁵Convinced of this, I know that I will remain and continue with you all, for your progress and joy in the faith,
 ²⁶so that in me you may have ample cause to glory in Christ Jesus, because of my coming to you again.
